

How to Install and Use the Client on Windows 7/8/10

1. Navigate to the library's homepage at: <https://www.library.ucdavis.edu>
2. Select: **Access VPN** (located in the top right corner of the page)

VPN Client for Desktops and Notebooks: Installation & Use

The VPN Client (Pulse Secure) needs to be downloaded and installed on your personal computer. Please use one of the links below for instructions on how to install, configure, and use the VPN Client. You only need to do this once. You need administrator rights to install it, if you do not have them, contact your department IT staff. After installation, make sure the client program is running before accessing licensed resources.

The VPN Client (Pulse Secure) should work for the majority faculty, staff & students; but it may not work with all operating systems. See [Questions & Known Issues](#).

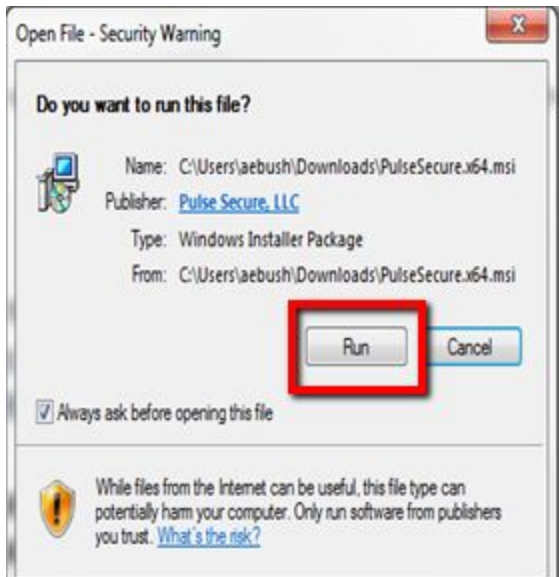

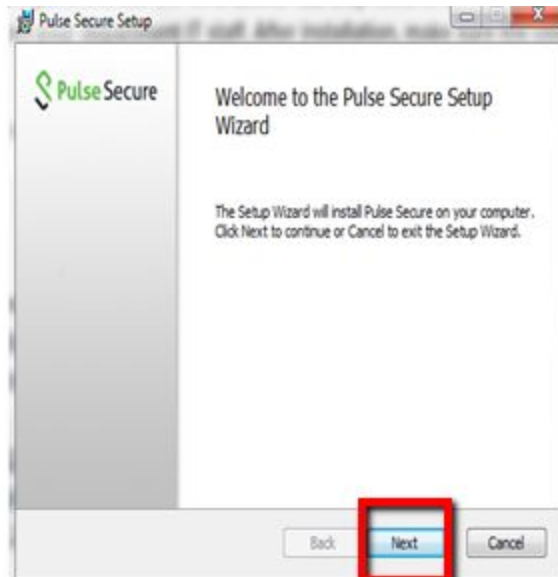

5. To run this file, select: **Run**

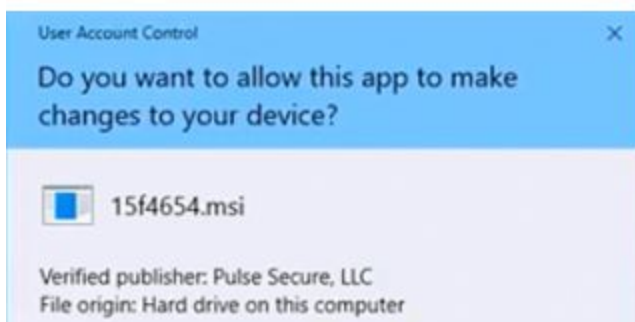


6. Select: **Next**

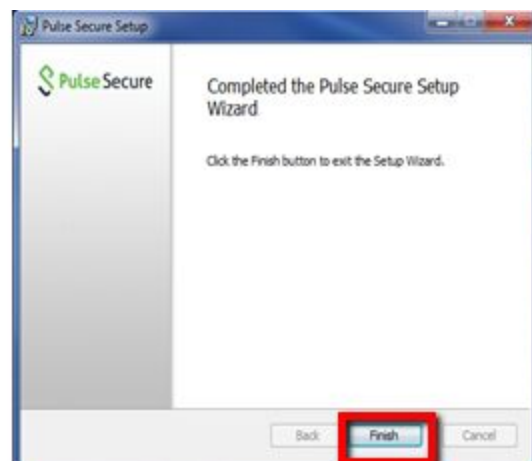


NOTE It should prompt you here if you are downloading the wrong bit version

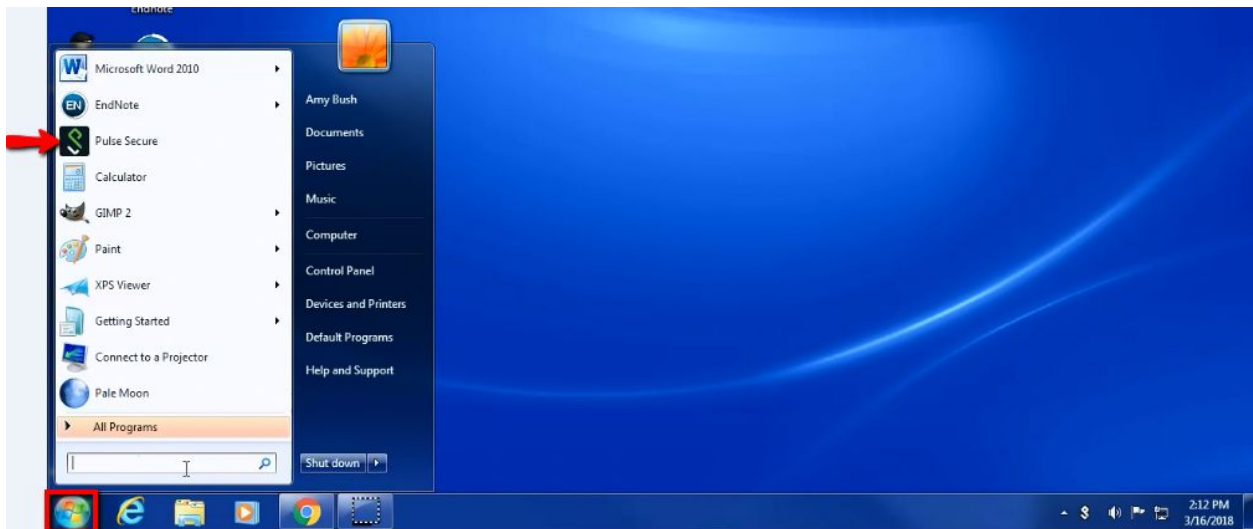
7. If you are asked to make changes to your device.

8. Select: **Finish** to exit the setup wizard



9. Navigate to the **Start Menu** and locate Pulse Secure.
Select: **Pulse Secure**



10. Select the **Plus Symbol**
to add a connection



11. Enter a Name: **Library VPN**
Server URL: **vpn.library.ucdavis.edu**
Click: **Add**



12. Select: **Connect** to Library VPN



13. Enter your UC Davis **Kerberos** login
Then select: **Connect**



14. Congratulations, you are now connected and have access to the library's resources!
